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### Viticulture Notes

A fine wine produced from grapes grown in Swannanoa.

The certified sustainable vineyard is located on the Northern banks of the Waimakariri river and the soil is very free draining silt loam ideal for grapevines producing high quality fruit.

Fantastic conditions over flowering meant that we faced over cropping. Aggressive shoot thinning was followed by crop thinning to ensure that the remaining fruit would ripen with the desired flavour profile.

Extremely warm conditions persisted over January and warm temperatures were experienced for the balance of the growing season. May saw a change to a series of cold southerlies dropping temperatures.

Harvest occurred on the 7<sup>th</sup> of May.

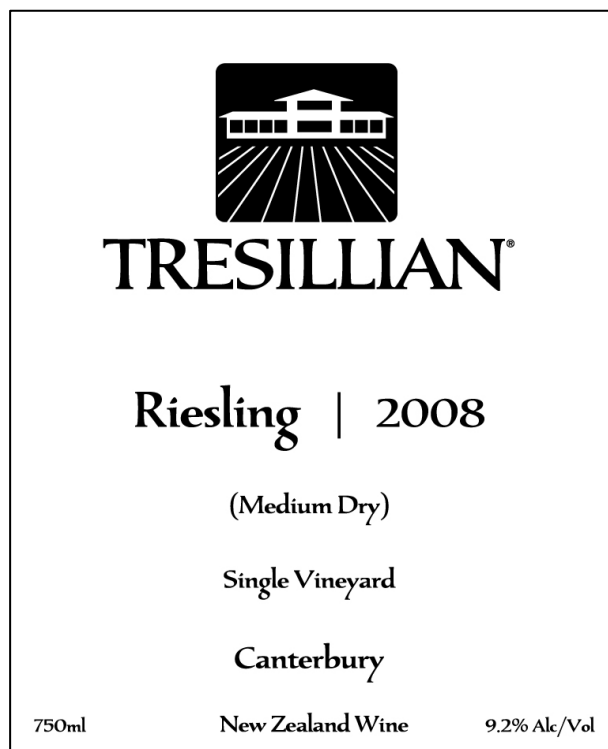
### Winemaker's Notes

The grapes were pressed immediately, and the clear juice then fermented slowly at low temperatures. The wine was handled carefully to retain a level of natural grapes sugars to balance the relatively high acids, and to retain the slight natural spritzig.

The aromas are driven by fresh Freesia spring flowers, while red apple, lemon and lime characters intermingle nicely to create a lively palate.

While ready to drink on release it should continue to improve over the next 3 –6 years and live for 10 years or more.

December 2010: After 2 years of bottle age, the wine has developed lovely honey aromas enhancing the initial floral, apple and citrus notes.
